Grace Center Inc. is a day resource program which opened in December 2011 to help people who are struggling with financial challenges, homelessness, mental health issues, and recovery over addictions. Grace Center is staffed by trained volunteers and a part-time MSW/Case Manager.

The program is hosted in rotation on different days of the week at three churches on Middle St. in Gloucester: Trinity Church, UCC; St. John's Episcopal Church; and the Unitarian Universalist Church. In addition, Temple Ahavat Achim, the Vajrmudra Center (Buddhist), and other Cape Ann faith communities provide financial and volunteer support to the Grace Center.
